

NAOMI HOUSE - WEST LOS ANGELES VA

The Naomi House is run by the Salvation Army with a Memorandum of Agreement with the VA and is co-located at the West Los Angeles VAMC. The address is 11301 Wilshire Blvd., Bldg. 207 & 212, Los Angeles, CA 90073. Kathy Geer is the Program Manager and point of contact and can be reached at 310-478-3711 ext. 44353.

The Naomi House is a recovery-oriented program that provides emergency housing, supportive services and transitional living for 15 female veterans. The Program offers individual assessment, case management, and psycho-educational groups, in a women-only environment that provides a social support system of peers and addresses issues common to homeless women veterans.

Participants in the Program have access to individual therapy, women's groups, domestic violence counseling, and treatment for sexual trauma and/or Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), and family reunification services. Though designed to be a one year program, residents are welcome to stay for up to two years.

Working in collaboration with the VA Medical Center, Naomi House residents are provided with medical and mental health services in a structured environment. They also receive assistance in life skills development, money management, relapse prevention, employment and permanent housing as preparation for re-entry into the community.

Graduates return to the community as contributing members to live healthy, independent, productive and fulfilling lives.
