Information from our Western Division Education Chairman, here's information and dates to watch for.

The Non-Traditional Scholarship can be awarded to a Legionnaire or SAL member as well, so make sure they are also getting the application form. Also check with the military families in your local area as many spouses are returning to college to finish their education or could use this assistance.

Remember the applicant must be a member of the ALA, A Legion or Sons of The American Legion and have paid dues for the proceeding two (2) years and for the current calendar year in which the application is made.

The Spirit of Youth Scholarship is an umbrella that supports three separate scholarship opportunities for participates of The American Legion Auxiliary, Junior members; another is for the Honorary National Junior President; and one is for participants in the American Legion Auxiliary Girls Nation program – all eligible Junior member apply – you get to pick the winner from our department and one will be selected out of the ten for our Western Division.

A reminder – please read through the Scholarship forms and is aware of the requirements and dates. Students, who do not meet the basic requirements as stated in the Scholarship forms, leave off information or do not meet the deadlines, will not be considered make sure they are certified before mailing in.

National Scholarships: National President's Children of Warriors, Spirit of Youth and Non-Traditional Scholarship.

Dates to remember: March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012 on or before – receive signed scholarship applications from Units. March 15<sup>th</sup> on or before –send to Department Secretary for Certification.
