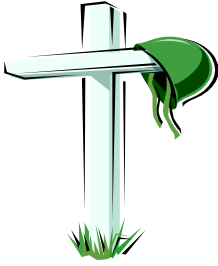
There will be a Memorial Eulogy for Past Department President Virginia Gandy and all deceased members who have passed away this past year.
