SUBJECT: NANCY BROWN PARK'S CAMPAIGN

At the Post Department Executive Committee Meeting in June, I made a packet for each District President to share with her District and to each Area Coordinator. Hopefully this has been done.

We are privileged to have a candidate for National President for the year 2013-2014. It has been over 25 years since California had our last National President Josie Melgard in 1985-86.

We need to raise funds of \$75,000 to \$100,000 for Nancy's campaign and year in office. This is a lot of money but it amounts to \$3-\$4 per member. We are asking each Unit/District/Area to do what they can to help realize this goal. Many things that our National organization paid for in the past they are no longer able to do. We have all had to tighten our belts in these uncertain economic times, and National is no different.

We will be having a statewide candy drive beginning in January. There are 45 candy bars per box at \$1 each, and 4 boxes to a case. These candy bars are very easy to sell. We need to offer them to everyone in which we have contact. Please let your District President know before November 1st how many boxes you can sell between January through April. I will be delivering them at the DEC in January. If you can pay for them upfront it would help us tremendously. If not, pay for them after your sales. We receive \$.50 profit for each candy bar. (Each case of 180 candy bars would be \$180.00.)

There are many fundraising activities that you can do to help raise the needed funds and a list of possibilities was given to each District President. The only limitation is your imagination.

Nancy would like to attend any large event for her campaign, schedule permitting. More information can be found on her website www.nancybrownpark.com.

I have been asked how the funds would be used. Here are some of the items: 15,000-16,000 pins; 500 coins for special guests; professional photos; receptions at Washington Conference 2011 and 2012 with give aways; gifts for Department Presidents, NEC, National Officers and Chairmen, National Commander and wife, National SAL Commander and wife, and National Headquarters staff; Homecoming expenses; numerous meetings for interviewing; some transportation and housing. These are just a few of the expenses.
