Rules: 1<sup>st</sup> place awards for Best Unit Supplemental, Best District Supplemental, Senior and Junior Volunteer of the Year, Largest Unit Donation to CDF and Largest District Donation to CDF will be given out onstage at Dept. Convention in June. All other awards and citations will be given out in the pre-convention committee meeting.

To qualify for Dept. awards details included in the Unit and/or District supplemental should include details such as, how event was organized, hours worked, # of volunteers, money raised and other successes of the particular event or activity. Supplementals should be typed and no more than 1000 words.

### Senior & Junior Volunteer of the Year Award

A senior and junior member from each Division will be honored for outstanding service in at least one activity emphasized in the Plan of Action. To be eligible for the award, volunteer service must be provided during the 2010-2011 administrative year. The application (which can be found on the Dept. website as well as in your March bulletin) must be fully completed with required certification and a narrative of 300 to 500 words must be completed by the entrant. Unit entry must be submitted to the District Community Service Chairman by April 22, 2011. Each District Chairman will select a winning entry and submit the entry to the Department Chairman, no later than May 13, 2011.

### Unit Award

A citation will be presented to the Unit in each Division with the most outstanding overall promotion of the Community Service Program during the 2010-2011 administrative year. Each entry must include at least two of the designated areas of special emphasis. Entry must be in narrative form not to exceed 1,000 words. The Unit name and address, name of the Department and a completed copy of the annual report form also must be included. Entry must be postmarked by May 1, 2011, and sent to the Department Community Service Chairman. Each Department Chairman will select a winning entry and submit the entry to the Division Chairman, postmarked by June 1, 2011.
