Answer: Yes, but only in an emergency. According to the U.S. Flag Code, flying the flag upside down is a signal of distress and indicates extreme danger to life or property. It means "Help Me! It's an emergency! I am in dire trouble and need immediate help!"

Why must the flag be folded in such a specific way?

Answer: The U.S. flag is folded into a triangle shape to honor and show respect for the flag, symbolizing the tri-cornered hats worn by colonial soldiers. This method ensures the flag is handled with dignity and preserves its condition.

How many versions of the flag have been designed?

Answer: There have been 27 official versions of the American flag. The current 50-star version, designed by 17-year-old Robert G. Heft in 1958 as a school project, has been in use since July 4, 1960.

How many U.S. flags made it to the moon?

Answer: The U.S. flag has been placed on the moon by an astronaut during six Apollo missions (11, 12, 14, 15, 16, and 17).
