- 5. Libraries: aid to public library (we could hold a book drive, collect, and donate books to libraries or Nursing Homes, be sure to include ALA's magazines.
- Community Councils: District and Unit Community Services Chairman, try to attend your local City Council meeting for the betterment of working together in your local community. Get involved, you are the ALA Department of Labor.
