Here are some ways members and Units can increase awareness and provide support to the military community:

- Give handcrafted thank you cards made by Junior members to veterans residing in veterans homes and assisted living facilities.
- Donate Thanksgiving gifts or care packages to junior-enlisted members and their families who are stationed at a military base in your area.
- Adopt a military family for the holidays by donating food baskets and/or toys to the families of junior-enlisted military service members in nearby communities.
- Offer a military neighbor volunteer childcare time so they can run errands or just have some 'me-time' to recharge.
- Thank active duty service members, veterans, military spouses, or military children for their service.
- Visit war memorials with your children to teach them the value of service.
- Fly the U. S. flag.
