Department Essay Titles for 2023-24:		word count
Group I – Grades 4 & 5:	Why do we honor the flag?	200 - 300
Group II – Grades 6 & 7:	Why is voting important?	200 - 300
Group III – Grades 8 & 9:	Who is responsible to keep our country safe?	250 - 400
Group IV – Grades 10, 11, &12	Is service to our country important?	300 – 500
Group V – Special needs:	How should the flag be disposed of?	25 or more

# **Department Deadline Dates:**

- First Friday in March (March 1, 2024) Unit chairman pick-up essays from schools.
- Fourth Friday in March (March 22, 2024) Unit chairman forward winners only (in each group) to District chairman for judging.

<sup>\*</sup>Judging sheets are available on Department Website.

<sup>\*</sup>The essays titles must be exactly as published on website.

<sup>\*</sup>Student's name, address, group #, age (if special needs), grade, school name, teachers name, unit chairman's name, unit name and district number must be listed on back of essay.

<sup>\*</sup>Coversheet is to be completed by the student or parent and the unit submitting the essays.

<sup>\*</sup>Teacher or parents name and signature is required.

 Third Friday in April (April 19, 2024) District chairman forward winners only (in each group) to the Department chairman for judging.

#### **National Deadline Dates:**

- March 1<sup>st</sup> Unit picks-up essays from schools.
- March 15<sup>th</sup> Unit forward winners only (in each class) to District Chairman.
- March 29<sup>th</sup> District forward winners only (in each class) to Department Chairman.
- April 15<sup>th</sup> Department forward winners to National Western Division Chairman.
- (Please note deadline dates are different for Department and National)
