## MEMBERSHIP

The Goal for the Department of California is 18,428 members; at the end of DEC we were at 14,289 members, 77.59% of goal. We are over half way there! Western Division is in second place, 1.59% behind the Southern Division.

Last year at The National Convention we were shouting "The West is the best" we can do that again! However, we have 14 Units that have not transmitted members for 2024 and 22 Units that have under the 10-member requirement. We need to keep our focus on the prize of reaching our goal of 18,428.

## PROBLEMS WITH OBTAINING DD214

One of the concerns that I heard at DEC is what to do if we cannot get a DD214. I went on the national website (www.alaforveterans.org/join) and downloaded helpful tips in obtaining veterans' military records:

- Visit the National Archivers and Records Administration: archives.gov/veterans.
- The County Clerk and Recorders Office where the Veteran resided when he/she registered upon returning from service.
- The funeral home may have kept a copy of military honors that were provided.
- Monument company if a Veterans headstone or marker was ordered.
- If the veterans utilized a VA Home Loan, there may be a copy of the DD-214 with the title documentation.
- Veterans who signed up for the VA's eBenefits may be able to obtain a printable copy: ebenefits.va.gov.

We are well on our way to achieving goal for the 2024 year, but Gold Miners, keep your pans, shovels, and picks dusted off as we go for the GOLD. Remember: you are more important than gold!
