My Special Project is divided between two non-profit organizations that offer support services to Veterans:

- VPAN, or Veterans Peer Access Network, is the nation's first ever community-driven support network serving Veterans and their families, it is a LA County Department of Mental Health program that works with the VA and other partners to link Veterans to the services their earned. Services include helping veterans transition to civilian life, offers peer supportive services, help with housing, substance misuse support, workforce development and employment, healthcare, education, legal services, and miscellaneous needs. - <u>Veterans Transition Center of Monterey County</u> addresses medical, psychological, occupational, financial, educational and social issues.
